Offering envelopes are available at each entrance to the sanctuary or the church office.

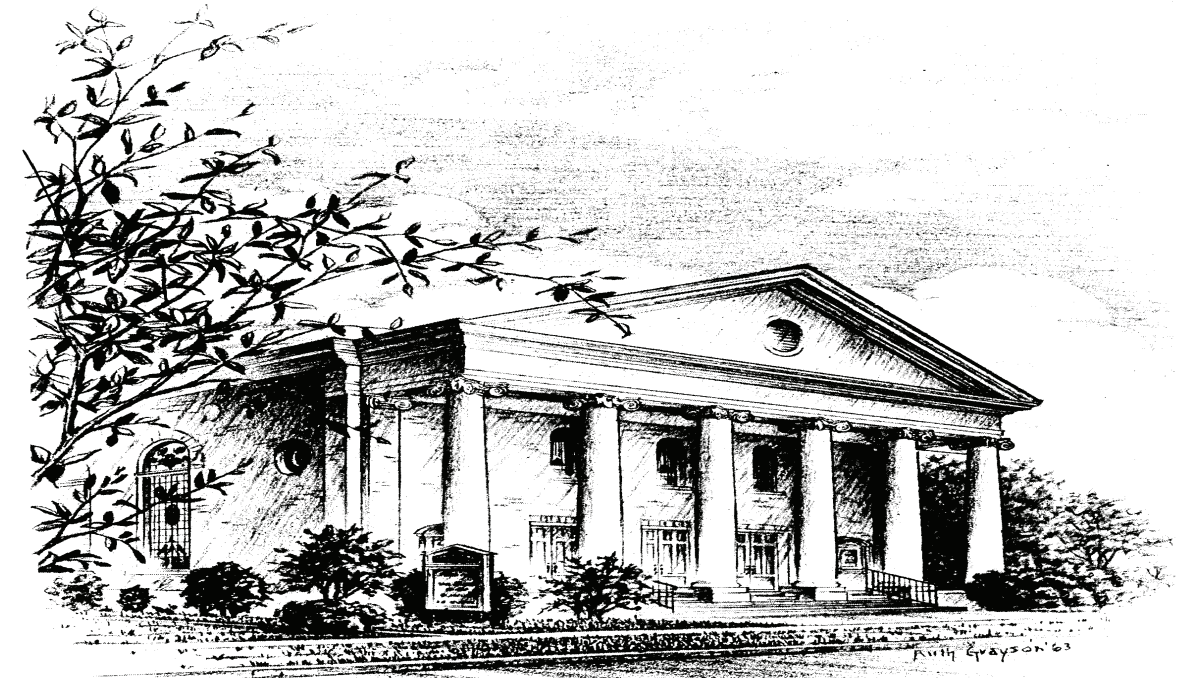
Gray Blades
